Our Teen Volunteers generally work at adoption events, helping the adults to talk with potential adopters, answer questions about our group and keep vacated cages clean. Some Teen Volunteers volunteer with their parent or other adult to clean cat cages in the adoption centers (anyone under 18 years old must be accompanied by an adult while in the adoption centers). Many Teen Volunteers use their experience with Fancy Cats to earn credits for community service for school, church or other organizations. We ask that our Teen Volunteers commit to volunteering with Fancy Cats for at least 4 hours each month and for at least 6 months.

If you become a volunteer with Fancy Cats, the information you provide in this application will be kept on file and shared with other volunteers unless you choose NOT to have it shared (see below). RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY

I am aware that handling, caring for, and coming into contact with cats, some of which are wild and not trained animals, pose potentially serious risks of injuries from biting, scratching, responding to other animals or perceived threats, and other unpredictable behaviors. I understand that I may be injured as a result of my negligence, the negligence of others, or through no fault of myself or anyone else, because of the nature of handling, caring for, and coming into contact with cats. I also understand that cats, even the most well trained, are often unpredictable, may be difficult to control, and dangerous.

I expressly assume the risk of property damage and injury to me, all others within my household, family members and guests, caused by cats with which I, any other person within my household, family members and guests may come into contact, care for, or handle. I hereby agree to waive or release any and all rights that I or my heirs may have to make a claim against Fancy Cats Rescue Team, Inc., its agents, employees, members, officers, directors, and staff (the "Team") arising from any damages, injury, or death which I or any family member might sustain or which might occur to any cat that I or any family member may handle, care for, or come in contact with, as a result of my participation with the Team.

I further agree to defend, indemnify and hold harmless the Team from any claims which I might make or which might be made on my behalf by others, or which might be made by members of my household, my family, or my guests, or which might be made against me by any other person, arising from handling, caring for, or coming into contact with cats as a result of my participation with the Team.

BY SIGNING THIS RELEASE AND WAIVER, I UNDERSTAND THAT I AM GIVING UP, (WAIVING AND RELEASING) ANY RIGHT I MIGHT HAVE TO SUE OR MAKE A CLAIM WHICH I MIGHT HAVE OR WHICH MIGHT SUBSEQUENTLY ARISE OR OCCUR AGAINST THE TEAM AND ITS AGENTS, EMPLOYEES, MEMBERS, OFFICERS, DIRECTORS, AND STAFF. IT IS MY INTENT TO GIVE UP THOSE RIGHTS AND PROVIDE THIS HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT, AND I DO SO KNOWINGLY AND VOLUNTARILY.
